- Programma del corso INGLESE - Conversation

PREREQUISITI: Livello B2 Common European Framework

Durata: 20 ORE

The course is designed for student with good knowledge of English who would like to practice their conventional skills.

During the classes you will be introduced to many new and exciting areas of the English Language usually not found in the textbook. The course places special emphasis on everyday skills needed for work related activities, travelling and general conversational skills.

The Keys areas we will be covering are: telephoning, socializing, arranging meetings and the trips and general conversation.

TOPICS OF CONVERSATION

General conversation: we will be taking about many different subjects within the course and each student will be able to bring to class and share information that you think could be of interest to the whole class.

Music, Theatre and Films: we will be looking into the world of music and films, discussing likes and dislikes, trying to understand the language used, very often different from what you are used to.

Debates: debates are a way of expressing your feelings towards a particular subject. This will help you to give your opinion on various issues in English, some of which you might feel strongly about.

Cultural Differences:

News in the World: we will be discussing news in the world using, when possible, some articles from newspapers from English speaking countries to compare differences of opinion between one nation and another and also the linguistic differences.
